Champion Frequently Asked Questions

How will my camper know what to bring to camp?

A complete packing list is available to download on our website. You will also receive one in your confirmation email when you register.

Who will my camper room with?

Campers are housed in Katie Rogers Residence Hall with either two or three campers per room. If desired, campers may request a roommate on their camp application. This request does not guarantee the requested roommate a space in camp. We will try our best to honor this request but it isn't guaranteed.

Can my camper be in the same group with ...?

Campers spend some of their day in assigned groups for a variety of learning experiences. Due to the large number of campers at Champion we cannot honor individual requests for group assignments. Every effort is made to provide for exciting and stimulating "assigned' group experiences to encourage interaction and fellowship, while also ensuring other times during each day for campers to self-select groups.

What if my camper gets sick?

Licensed health-care professionals are on duty daily serving the camps in case of illness and nearby Covenant and University Medical Center is used for emergencies. Any camper who is diagnosed with a contagious or communicable illness while at camp must be withdrawn from camp immediately for the safety of all campers.

What if my camper must take medication?

Parents must sign the medical form provided during online registration. Campers requiring medication must provide written instructions to the camp staff at check-in. Medicine will be dispensed by a licensed health professional.

What if my camper must cancel his/her reservation for camp? Will I receive a refund?

All campers are required to pay a non-refundable/non-transferable deposit of \$100 at the time of registration. This deposit allows us to make reservations for summer housing, food service and hire summer staff. Each camper may cancel their registration 6 days prior to the start of their camp session and receive a refund for any additional paid funds. Campers who fail to attend camp or do not give notice of their cancellation 6 days prior to the start of camp will forfeit all paid funds.

What is the time and location of check in?

Check-in for Champion will be in Katie Rogers Residence Hall Sunday 2:00 pm-5:00 pm. Campers will register in the parlor in Katie Rogers where they will receive their room and group assignment.

When and where can I pick up my camper?

At the end of each camp, campers can be picked up at Katie Rogers. Check out time is at 10:00 am on Friday. No supervision is provided for late pick-ups; please plan for each camper to be picked up at the appropriate time.

All parents are invited to attend a short presentation and end of week video on Friday at 9:00 am in the McDonald Moody Auditorium.

Dress Code

Shorts may be worn at Camp Champion. Shorts must be modest in style and length, mid-thigh or longer and appear modest while standing and sitting. Any clothing, accessories or symbols that imply gang affiliation are not acceptable and will not be allowed. No tank tops or midriff shirts will be allowed.

Will my camper be able to call home?

We are aware that many campers regularly carry cell phones, but we ask that campers leave all cell phones in the residence halls during the camp week. Campers are allowed to make calls from their personal phones during free time and in residence halls only. Any camper that is seen using a cell phone outside of the residence halls without the permission from the camp director will have the phone taken up and returned at the end of the week. The Camp Office will relay emergency messages during large group meetings.

Can I visit my camper while at camp?

For continuity and safety, all camps are closed campus. Campers are not allowed to leave campus and parents and visitors are not allowed in the dorms or on campus.

Parents are invited to attend closing ceremonies at the end of the camp session, which includes the viewing of a video presentation of the week's activities. This will be at 9:00 am on Friday in the McDonald Moody Auditorium.

Can I send mail to my camper at camp?

Yes! Camper mail will be delivered every afternoon to the dorm and handed out to your camper by their counselor each night. Each piece of mail should be addressed as follows:
