How will my camper know what to bring to camp?

A complete packing list is available to download on our website. You will also receive one in your confirmation email when you register.

Who will my camper room with?

Female Campers: Katie Rogers dorm will be closed for renovations this summer. The limited housing, we have on campus will be for **seniors and graduates**. They will be housed on campus in the Courtyards. There will be 3 girls in each room. You can email your housing request to me at terri.warren@lcu.edu in groups of 3. The rest of the girl campers will be housed down the street in one of Tech's dorms. There will be 2 to a room at Tech. We will bus the girls to and from campus to Tech. There will be counselors, desk sitters, night counselors and security at the dorms. If you are staying at Tech you will leave your luggage in your van until after Keynote.

Male Campers will get their room assignments in the Johnson Hall dorm. The guys will be housed three campers to a room so please plan accordingly.

What if my camper gets sick?

Licensed health-care professionals are on duty daily serving the camps in case of illness and nearby Covenant and University Medical Center is used for emergencies. Any camper who is diagnosed with a contagious or communicable illness while at camp must be withdrawn from camp immediately for the safety of all campers.

What if my camper must take medication?

Parents must sign the medical form provided during online registration. Campers requiring medication must provide written instructions to the camp staff at check-in. Medicine will be dispensed by a licensed health professional.

What if my camper must cancel his/her reservation for camp? Will I receive a refund?

All campers are required to pay a non-refundable/non-transferable deposit of \$100 at the time of registration. This deposit allows us to make reservations for summer housing, food service and hire summer staff. Each camper may cancel their registration 6 days prior to the start of their camp session and receive a refund for

any additional paid funds. Campers who fail to attend camp or do not give notice of their cancellation 6 days prior to the start of camp will forfeit all paid funds.

What is the time and location of check in?

Regular check-in for Encounter will be in the McDonald Moody Auditorium, Sunday 2-5pm. Campers will then proceed to get their room assignments in the dorms. If you arrive after 5:00 pm on Sunday you will register in the Moody foyer after the Keynote speaker.

We will not offer early check-in on Saturday.

We feel that it will be best to not have early check-in this year due to dorm renovations. Registration will be on Sunday only from 2:00-5:00. If you need to arrive on Saturday, you can check with area churches or hotels for that night.

When and where can I pick up my camper?

At the end of Encounter, campers can be picked up at their residence halls. The girls will be at the Tech Dorms. We will send more information and a map of where to pick them up.

The guys will be at Johnson Hall. Check out time is at 10:00 am on Saturday.

Dress Code

• Acknowledge and honor the LCU dress code in daily choices of attire.

Our camp facility, Lubbock Christian University, has an expectation of modest attire for all staff, students and community. As a camp we honor that policy. Please read the details that apply to our camps. All of the rules apply to guys and girls.

- Dress should be modest.
- These items are not acceptable: halter tops, bare midriffs, and revealing skirts and shorts,
- No loose fitting tank tops for guys or girls. Undergarments should not be seen at any time.
- No short shorts. If you are wearing shorts, we feel are inappropriate we will have long athletic shorts for you to change into.
- Clothing with inappropriate advertising, pictures, and/or sayings that are contrary to the mission and Christian standards of LCU is prohibited.
- Campers, staff and volunteers will be asked to return to their room and change any clothing that is inappropriate.

Camp Staff will make every effort to implement this policy in accordance with the stated expectations.

What if my child is on a waiting list?

Each camper spot is filled on a first come, first serve basis. If your child is placed on a waiting list, the camp office will contact you as soon as space becomes available.

Can I send mail to my camper at camp?
