Call to worship

↑ L (Sun) Grace and peace be upon you from God our Father, the Lord Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit.
(Mon) O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness; let the whole earth stand in awe of God.
(Tue) To you belongs the day, O God, to you also the night; you set in place the moon and the sun. You fixed all the boundaries of the land; you made summer and winter.
(Wed) I will bless the LORD, who gives me counsel; my heart teaches me, night after night. I have set the LORD always before me; he is at my right hand, I shall not fall.
(Thu) If I say, "Surely the darkness will cover me, and the light around me turn to night," darkness is not dark to you, O LORD; the night is as bright as the day; darkness and light to you are both alike.
